PARISH CENTRE UPDATE

To our Parishioners
 As you know, we have been moving forward with our plan to build a new Parish Centre with the next step of engaging an architect to design and oversee the building. Intersecting with this process is the larger Archdiocesan initiative *New Parishes: Stronger Together*, which, anticipates the amalgamation of parishes throughout the Archdiocese over the next year. On the peninsula, there will be three parishes – the union of St Thomas Aquinas Canadian Martyrs and St Agnes; the union of St Theresa's, St Mother Teresa of Kolkata, St Catherine of Sienna and St Patrick's; and, St Mary's Cathedral Basilica. With the significant transitions this year, we have been advised by the Archbishop that we are to postpone our building plans so that all of the members of our new parish can talk about our combined needs as well as the needs of the church on the whole peninsula. While we are taking the time to ensure we are making the best choices, we will be making some repairs to the Parish Hall to maintain it in good condition.
